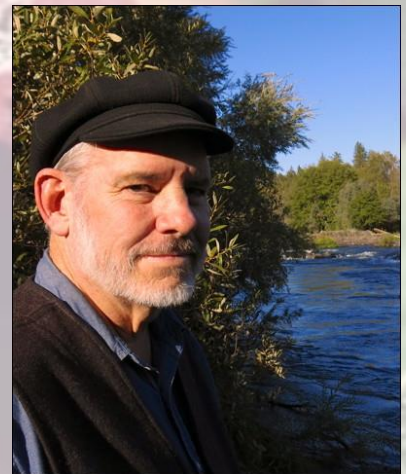

Thomas Doty is a native storyteller. Since 1981, he has traveled the countryside performing and teaching traditional and original stories. He learned his art from native elders, including Grandma Maude, the family storyteller. Doty was born in southern Oregon where he still lives. He is descended from Shasta and Takelma people, as well as from Irish and English settlers.

He is the author of several books, including *Doty Meets Coyote*, published in 2016 by Blackstone Publishing. His stories have been broadcast on Public Radio, and he is the recipient of a Distinguished Lifetime Achievement Award from the national American Indian Program. He has been called, "A Cultural Treasure" and "A Master of his Art."
